

- 1. Inspect all parts and sand or file any burrs or imperfections. Be very careful of the handlebars, they are very thin and will break fairly easy.
- 2. Prepare parts for painting by washing in water with a drop of dishwashing liquid. This will remove any oil residue and allow paint to adhere properly.
- 3. Drill out the holes for axles/pins with a .025 drill bit
- 4. Mount tires on rims. May need to sand for proper fit.
- 5. Slide pin through rim, cut off excess, apply glue to end of pin and insert into drilled whole.
